III. Treasurer's Report - Becky Haley

A. Monthly update

We had a starting balance of \$2,944.21. We had an income from membership dues of \$22, Wow Shirts \$12, and Vending \$129.05, for a total net cash of \$163.05. Purchases made include Kindergarten Parent night, Box Top party, and Teacher Dinner (expenses total \$215.07). This leaves the PTO treasury with a \$2,892.19 available balance.

IV. Fundraising Results

A. Spirit Wear - Jessi Patterson

We sold 339 Spirit Wear items which is about \$3,000 worth. We sent in an advance payment of 50% of the total.

- B. Pastries Lisa Christianson
 - We were short of our goal of \$3,000 in sales, but were not discouraged since this was our first freezer item in some time. We needed to sell 600 items to reach our goal, which worked out to 125 students selling 5 each, but we sold 365 items with 62 students / families participating in the fundraiser. We will see approximately \$1,600 come back to us.
